Professional Services:

Professional consultation with licensed personnel 24 hours a day for expert advice to meet your needs. Arrangement conference with family members, coordination with hospital or care facility and attending physician, contacting clergy, church, musicians, florists, caterers, cemetery, composing and submitting obituary notices (not the cost of notices), and attending to all other details required to fulfill the family's wishes.

Registration and Documentation:

Includes preparing, filing and securing all required Provincial and legal documentation as well as Estate Fraud Protection. Includes staff and vehicle use to retrieve Medical Certificate from the attending Physician when required.

Staff and Direction of Ceremonies:

Licensed Funeral Director and required support staff needed to direct the Funeral Service. Includes the use of Funeral Home equipment for the Funeral Service.

Personal Care of Deceased:

Licensed Embalmer for: bathing, feature setting and casket replacement of the deceased.

Embalming:

Sanitation, restoration and preservation using the latest embalming techniques by qualified, experienced and licensed embalmers. Includes embalming process, dressing, cosmetology, and casket placement of deceased.

Facilities:

The Funeral Home facility and equipment which includes the use of Funeral Home for clerical functions, arrangement offices, preparation facilities and equipment for the embalming and safekeeping of the deceased as well as all other facilities that relate to maintaining our services.

Evening Visitation:

7pm to 9pm with evening attendant (Food is not permitted at visitations)

Local Transfer of Deceased:

Transfer of the deceased from place of death into the care of Serenity Funeral Service. (A mileage fee will be charged for transfers beyond our regular service area)

Service Vehicle:

To transport staff, flowers and equipment to the ceremony, to act as a lead vehicle when leading a funeral procession to a cemetery.

Funeral Coach:

Vehicle used to transport the deceased on day of service to church and or cemetery.

AFSRB Government Fee:

Alberta Funeral Service Regulatory Board fee added to all Serenity Funeral Service Contracts.

Association Fees:

Provincial and Federal Association fees added to all Serenity Funeral Service Contracts.
